Chains by Jean Grisoni

Artist-designer and jewelry author, Jean Grisoni will present at the MiniMasterpiece gallery a new and exceptional set of 16 pieces.

Born in Algeria in 1950, Jean Grisoni draws most of his inspiration from his native Mediterranean. Marked by his roots, his brutalist poetry is charged with the mineral aridity of the coastline, the very particular light of the desert roughness, the discreet and austere sensuality of its inhabitants and the power of the cultural references which immerse each moment.

Polished or rusted steel, driftwood, antique pearls, gold, silver, bronze, Jean Grisoni combines and plays with these raw or precious elements to compose his jewelry, each one unique and made by his hand. Over time, the chain has become the backbone of his wearable sculptures, which he creates and recreates without ever repeating himself.

Galerie MiniMasterpiece, created in the Spring of 2012 by Esther de Beaucé, is the first Parisian gallery exclusively dedicated to the edition and sale of jewellery by renown contemporary visual artists and designers. Like a very private collection that one wears and carries along, artists jewellery first strike by the love, the friendship and the challenge that have preceeded their existence. These miniature works of art tell us about another History of Art, that of intimacy and passion. For collectors, choosing an artist or a designer jewel, wearing it around the neck, the wrist or the finger, is a statement. For the artists it is both a pastime and a challenge, that is to achieve the successfull confrontation of their monumental work to the scale of the body.
